It's Your Choice Enrollment Period Proposed Kick-Off Meeting Date Set

It's Your Choice Enrollment Period Proposed for October 3 - 28, 2011

The proposed 2012 It's Your Choice Enrollment period is October 3 - 28, 2011. The Group Insurance Board (Board) is set to act on this recommendation at its June meeting. Last year, the It's Your Choice Enrollment period took place over four weeks—one week more than the traditional period. That additional week was well-received by many payroll representatives and we believe that a four-week period can be accommodated again this year.

Attend the It's Your Choice Kick-Off Meeting: September 21, 2011

Each year, ETF hosts an It's Your Choice meeting for state agencies' payroll and personnel representatives and health plan and pharmacy benefit representatives. ETF staff members share information and discuss procedures regarding the It's Your Choice Enrollment period. This year, the potential exists for a variety of important changes that could be made effective January 1, 2012. Attached is a map showing directions to the Mendota Mental Health Institute's Conference Center Building in Madison. Mendota Mental Health Institute is located on the north side of Madison on Lake Mendota. From either the north or south, take interstate 90/94 to Highway 30 into Madison. From Highway 30, exit to Highway 113 north toward the Dane County airport. Stay on Highway 113 (Northport Drive) and turn on either Troy Drive or Knutson Drive (look for the tall smokestack). Parking Directions:

When traveling on Troy Drive to Mendota Mental Health Institute, turn left on North Road near the water tower and follow the signs to the Conference Center parking next to Building 107. The park-

ing lot is a short walk to the Conference Center crossing over a service road (Lorenz Road), to enter the building on the southeast side of the building. Handicap parking is located in the parking lot connected to the Conference Center/Food Service Building, with the handicap access on the southwest side of the building.
