August 16, 2017	Text in the “What is the ICI Enrollment Setup for myETF?” section	<p><b>The first sentence formerly read:</b></p> <p>As part of the effort to prepare myETF Employer Online Services for employer use in January 2018, employers who offer ETF-administered Income Continuation Insurance (ICI) must submit data elements associated with ICI-covered employees.</p> <p><b>This sentence was changed to:</b></p> <p>As part of the effort to prepare myETF Employer Online Services for employer use in January 2018, employers who offer ETF-administered Income Continuation Insurance (ICI) must submit data elements associated with employees who are or could potentially be covered by ETF-administered ICI.</p>
August 16, 2017	Introductory Text for the ICI Annual Data File	<p><b>The text formerly read:</b></p> <p>Employers will submit a record for each current employee with an ICI election. This includes current and future-dated elections. If an employee has an ICI Election record above, then an ICI Annual Data record is required and vice versa.</p> <p><b>This text was changed to:</b></p> <p>Employers will submit a record for each WRS eligible employees with or without an ICI election. The information on those employees without a current ICI election is necessary to accommodate employees who may add ICI during the enrollment period.</p>
