

Corrections/Clarifications/Updates to the 2011 *It's Your Choice: Decision Guide*

Wisconsin Public Employers' (WPE) booklet:

- On **Page 7**, the *Important Changes* chart under *Significant Health Plan Provider Network Changes* regarding Health Traditions Health Plan erroneously lists Grant County. It should read: **“Will no longer offer Luther Midelfort and Red Cedar providers. This impacts Barron, Chippewa, Dunn, Eau Claire, Pepin and St. Croix counties.”**
- On **Page 26**, the 2011 *Local Government Employees and Annuitant Rates* for all Local Medicare Annuitants have decreased. The rates that appear in the online version of the booklet include the reductions in the appropriate columns.

The reduced premiums were prompted by the 2010 federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) provisions that apply to the eventual closing of the Medicare Part D coverage gap (also referred to as the “donut hole”).

The monthly health insurance premium reduction for annuitants enrolled in Medicare and the DeanCare Rx Medicare Part D prescription drug plan (PDP) is \$66.10 for both Medicare Single coverage and Medicare Family 1 coverage. The reduction for Medicare Family 2 coverage is \$132.20.

This change was approved on November 9, 2010 by the Group Insurance Board for the prescription drug coverage rates for annuitants enrolled in Medicare and this program. This affects the portion of the premium used for the prescription drug coverage under the DeanCare Rx PDP, administered by Dean Health Insurance (DHI).

- On **Page 71**, the *Grievances and Complaints by Health Plan* chart has been replaced to reflect the total number of complaints and grievances per 100 members for each Health Plan during the 2009 calendar year.
