State of Wisconsin Employees, Annuity Holders, Continuity Holders and Graduate Assistants:

- On **page 4**, the first bullet point in the second row has been clarified to read: “●Adding a 10% coinsurance for non-preventive medical services, annual Out-of-Pocket Maximum (OOPM) of \$500 **individual** / \$1,000 for a family.”
- On **page 4**, the asterisked footnote in the second row has been clarified to read: “***Annuity Holders and their dependents on Medicare as their primary payor will see no change to their benefits.**” Previously, the italicized words above had read “members”.
- On **page 5**, the second bullet in the second row has been moved into a new row. The row header remains “New enrollment opportunities”. The middle column reads “**Standard Plan**”. The final column continues to read “Employees who are not enrolled but who want to preserve their sick leave as credits for use later, may enroll immediately prior to retirement.”
- On **page 12**, *Frequently Asked Question #3* cites a federal website that has been re-named. The site can now be found at the address:

- On **page 29**, the *Health Plan Map 2012* under *Kewaunee County* erroneously lists Anthem Blue Northeast (AE) as available with limited providers but not qualified. The icon AE should be bolded and be followed by an asterisk which means the plan is qualified in a county with no hospital.
- On **pages 32, 33 and 34**, an asterisked footnote on the bottom of the pages cites a federal website that has been re-named. The site can now be found at the address:
