State employees: 2011 rates are effective April 1, 2011 through March 31, 2012; 2012 rates are effective April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013. Each Unit of Spouse and Dependent Insurance is \$2.50 per month.

Local government employees: 2011 rates effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; 2012 rates effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. Each Unit of Spouse and Dependent Insurance is \$1.75 per month.

*Premiums for age 65-69 are required as long as employment continues.

Monthly Rates for Additional Coverage for Employees Age 70 and Older
(Effective January 1, 2011)

**When an active employee reaches age 70:

- Basic coverage continues at a reduced level without further premiums.
- Supplemental coverage ceases.
- Additional coverage will continue until the employee cancels coverage, stops paying premiums or terminates employment.
- Additional coverage rates for employees age 70 and older are listed below.
