Subject: LRWL's roles and responsibilities in the implementation of BAS

This memo is for informational purposes only. No Committee action is required.

The Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF) has undertaken a multi-year strategic initiative to transform, integrate and modernize its information technology systems. The integrated IT system is called the Benefits Administration System (BAS).

To ensure the success of this initiative, ETF engaged LRWL, a technology and management consulting firm specializing in public pension and benefits administration, to co-develop the request for proposal (RFP) for the vendor selection and to provide project management oversight during the implementation. Fourteen months into this modernization initiative, Rollout 1-Imaging and Basic Workflow, is currently scheduled to go live on July 20, 2015.

Attached is an overview of LRWL's roles and responsibilities in this multi-year initiative. Peter Cole, LRWL Oversight Project Manager, will be at the Audit Committee meeting for the presentation.

DATA CLEANSING AND CONVERSION

- Access to solution is role-based
- All user activities are logged:
 - Can determine all actions taken against an individual member
 - Can determine all actions taken by an individual staff member
- All additions and changes to data made through the programmatic interface
