## **BIENNIAL BUDGET UPDATE**

Ms. Hunter provided an update on the current version of the 2013–2015 state biennial budget proposal and the items that pertain to the Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF). Her update included the Transformation, Integration, and Modernization (TIM) initiative, passive review, rehired annuitants, ETF building, federal compliance changes, and funding for actuarial studies. She discussed the Joint Survey Committee on Retirement Systems meeting and related budget provisions.

#### **OPERATIONS UPDATE**

Mr. Stohr provided an operations update comparing the first guarter of 2013 to 2012.

- Retirement estimates were up 7.2% when compared to 2012.
- Retirement applications were up 16.44% when compared to 2012.

### **DEPARTMENT PROJECT PORTFOLIO**

Mr. Swanton, ETF Project Management Office, presented a document describing ETF portfolio of projects and took questions.

## TRANSFORMATION, INTEGRATION, AND MODERNIZATION INITIATIVE

Mr. Martin provided a status report on the TIM initiative. One major highlight is the Benefits Administration System (BAS) Request for Proposal (RFP), which was released last week. Another highlight is the contract completion for the financial management system.
