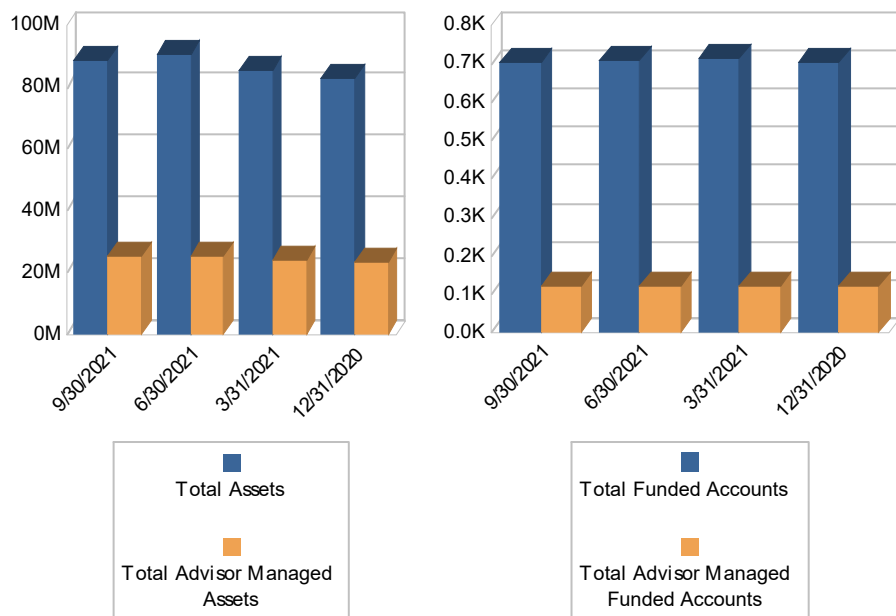

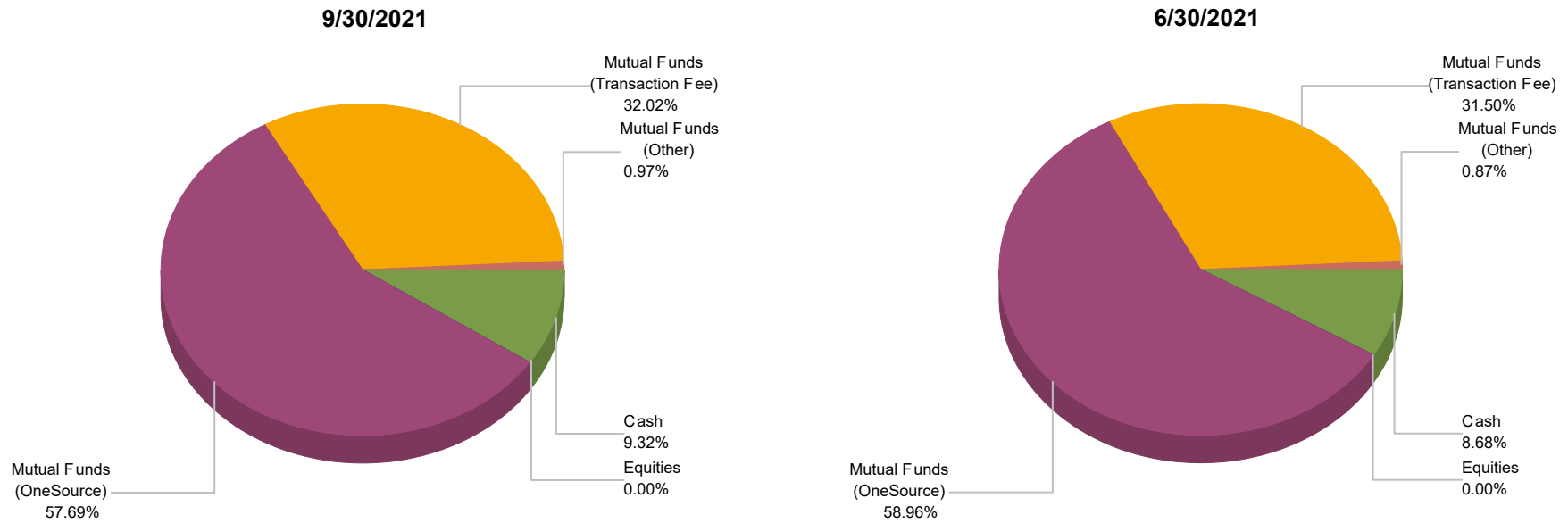

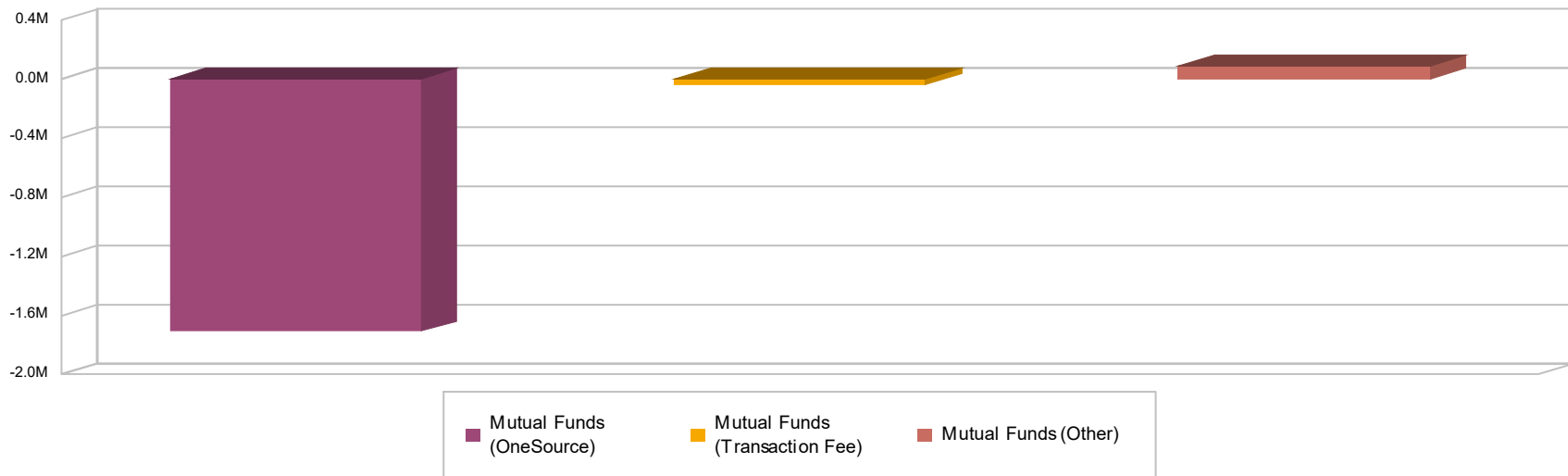

### Net Flow - All Non-Cash Assets (3-Month Period Ending 9/30/2021)

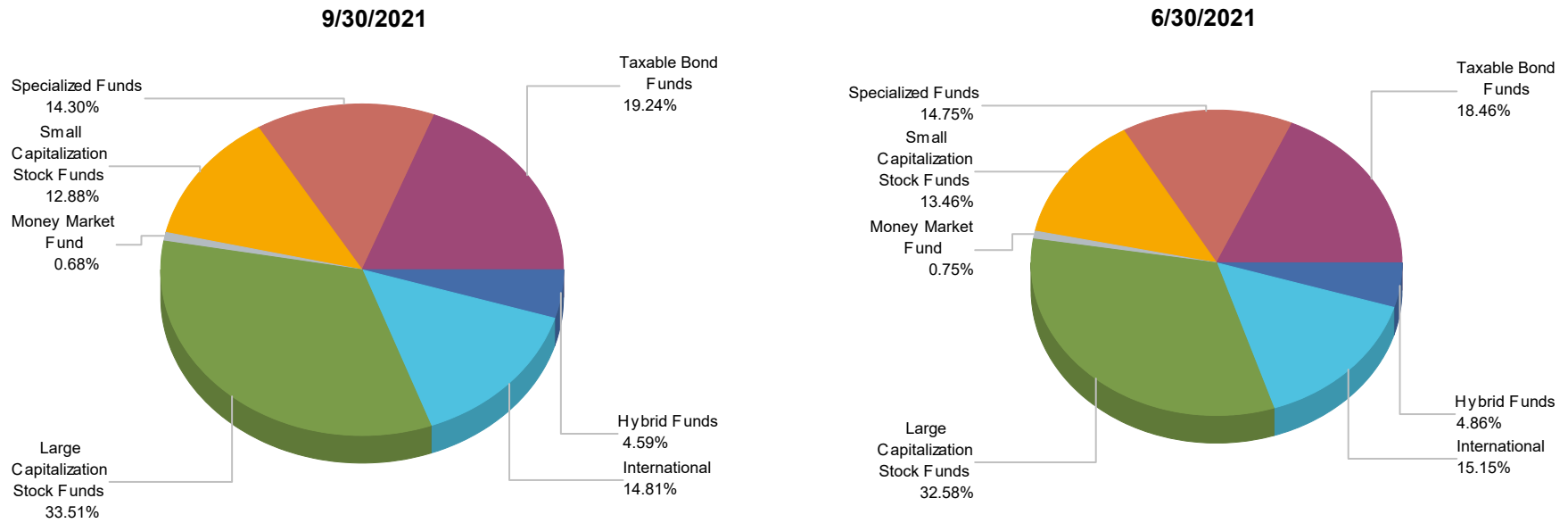

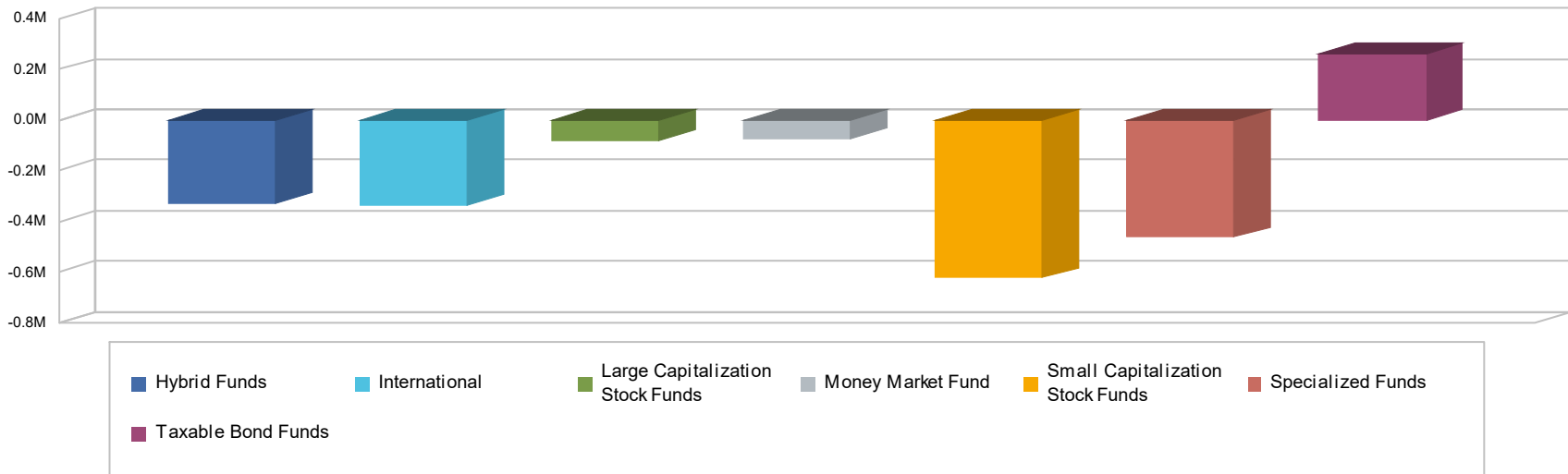

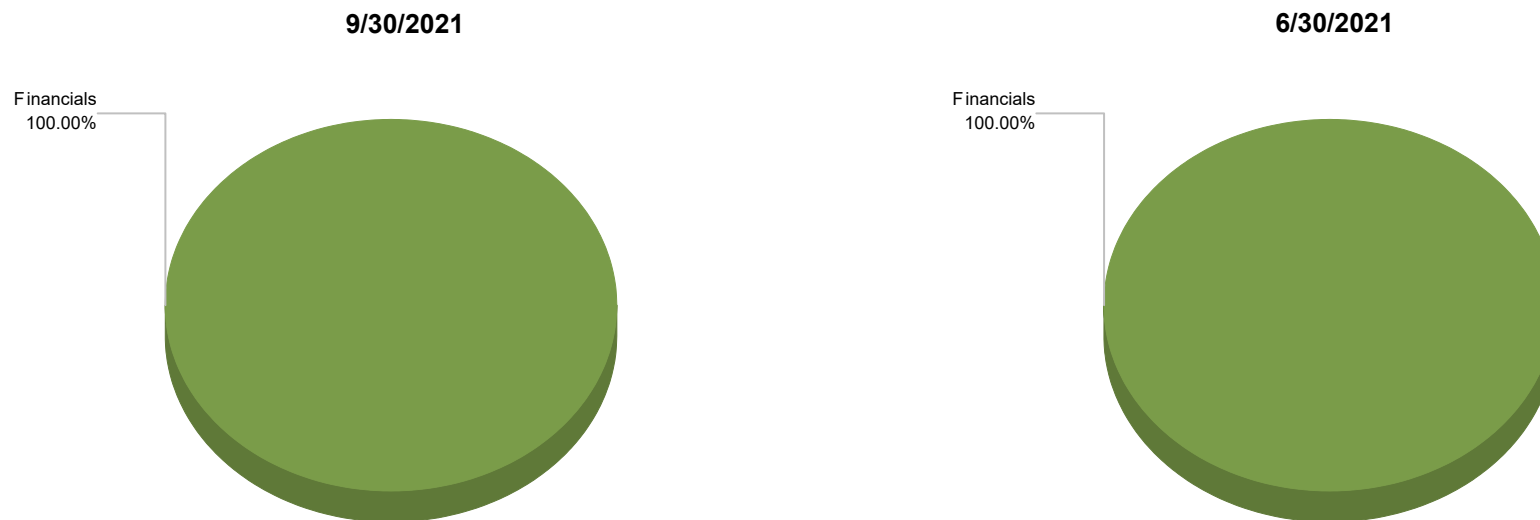
### Net Flow by Sector - Mutual Funds (3-Month Period Ending 9/30/2021)

## Net Flow by Sector - ETF (3-Month Period Ending )

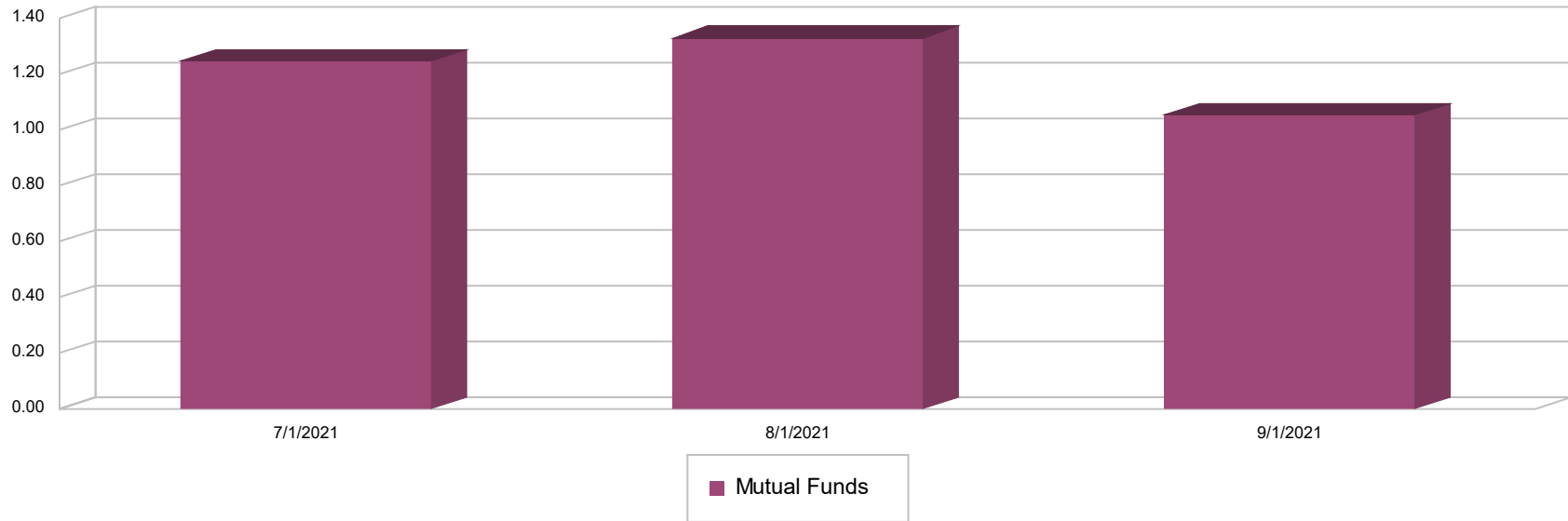

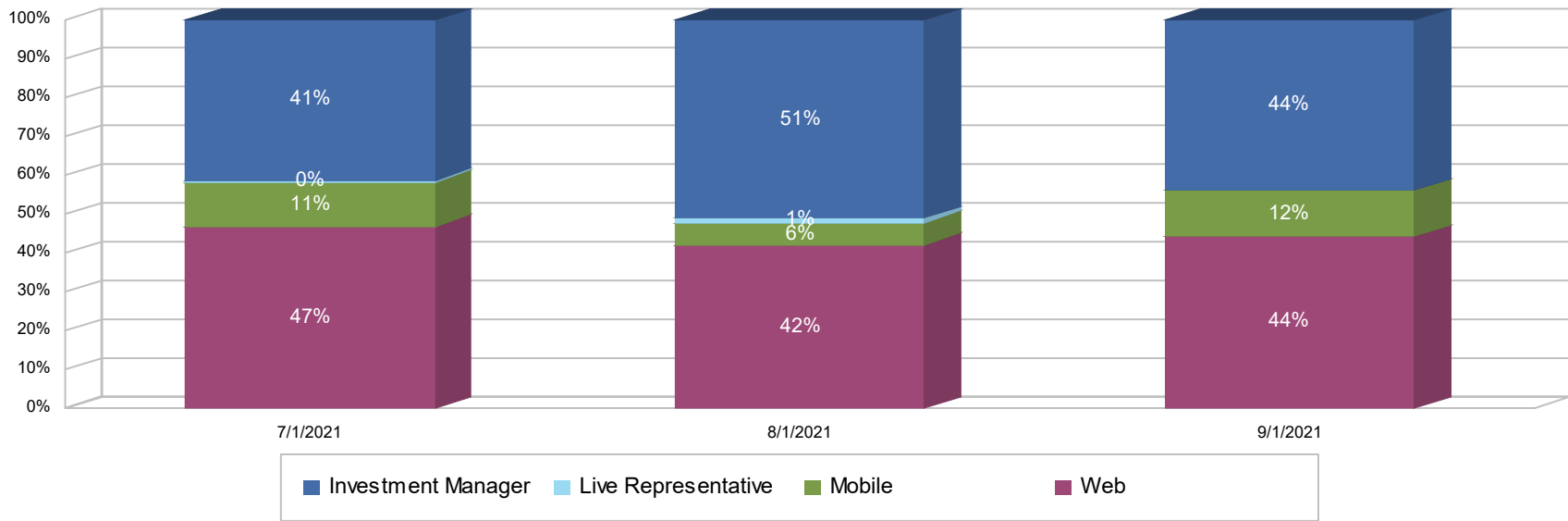
