ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REVISIONS

Mr. Nispel requested the Board's approval of revisions to Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapters 10 and 50. The Department proposes to amend s. ETF 10.08 (2) (b) 4. and create s. ETF 50.30 (4), relating to termination of employment and administrative leave of absence. The proposed rule reflects current ETF interpretation of s. 40.63, Stats., regarding permitting a disabled employee, who is on a leave of absence and not expected to return to service, to apply for a disability annuity benefit and receive such benefits if the application is approved. The proposed rule will conform the eligibility criteria regarding termination of employment for s. 40.63, Stats. disability annuities with the criteria regarding long-term disability insurance benefits under s. ETF 50.54 (2) (b).

Motion: Mr. Koessl moved to approve the final version of the proposed rule. Mr. Woodzicka seconded the motion, which passed without objection on a voice vote.
