Subject: Retirement Services Update

This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

Please find attached the *Retirement Services Update* report, including data from the fourth quarter of 2017. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and annuity payment information for the Wisconsin Retirement System.

The number of retirement estimate requests received during the fourth quarter of 2017 was 5.3% higher than the same period in 2016. For retirement benefit applications received, there was no change in the fourth quarter of 2017 as compared to the same time period in 2016.

Comparing full calendar years, the number of retirement estimate requests received during 2017 was 6.0% higher than in 2016. Retirement benefit applications received during 2017 were 3.1% higher than in 2016.

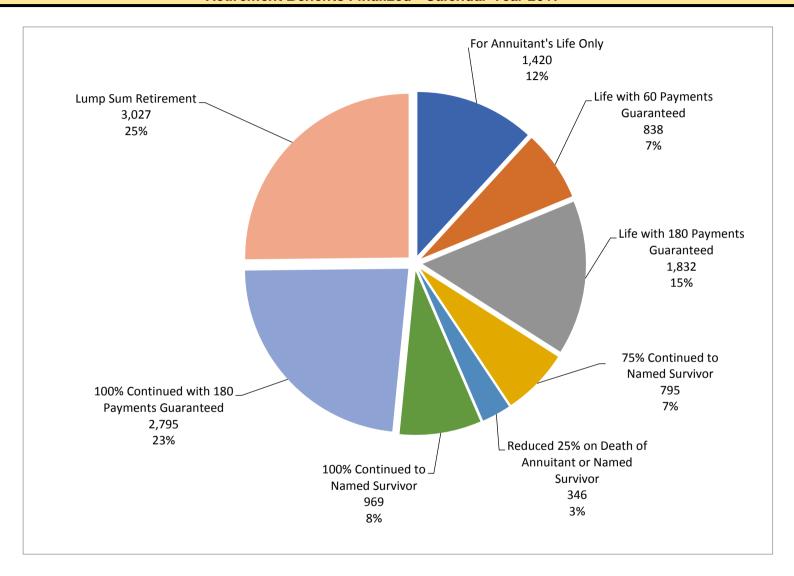

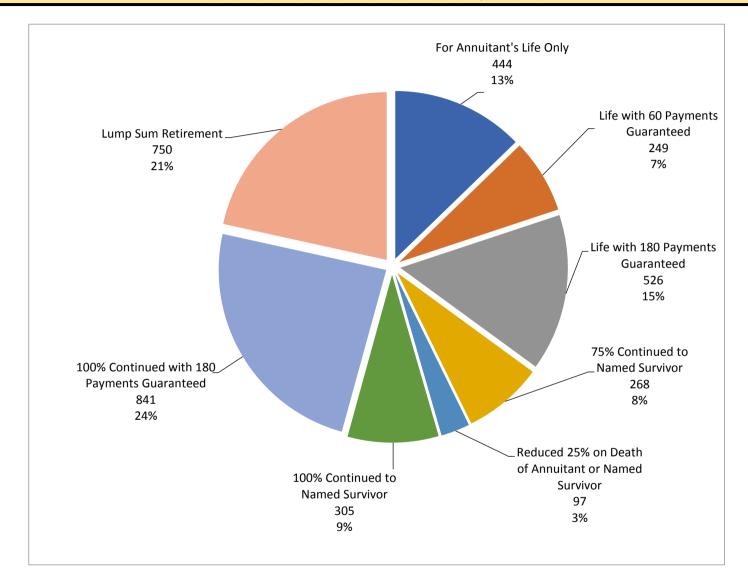

Retirement Benefits Finalized - By Calculation Method

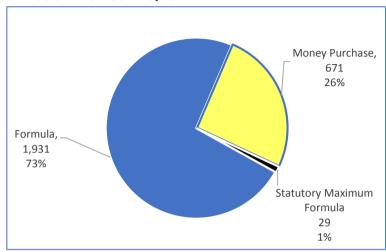

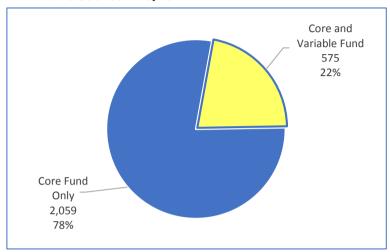

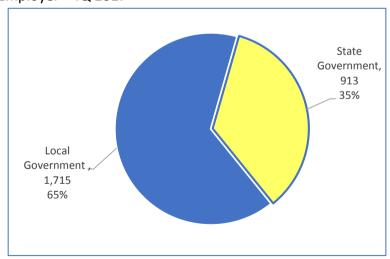
Calculation Method - 4Q 2017



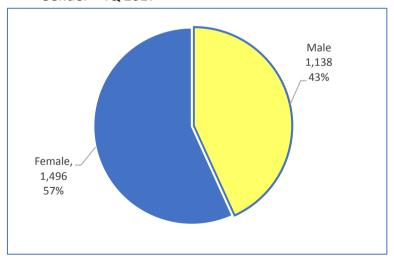
Fund Source - 4Q 2017

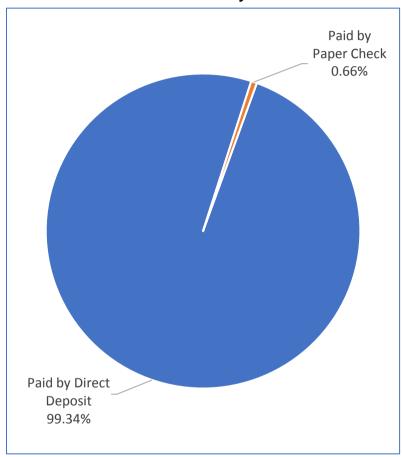
