New Video for Teachers

The Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF) recently published a new video, "Preparing for Your Retirement for K-12 Staff." The video, tailored for teachers and other K-12 staff who are within five years of retirement, is Part 1 of a three-part video series that covers the following topics:

- Preparing for retirement
- Applying for retirement
- Living in retirement

The approximately 13-minutes video explains how the Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS) retirement benefit is determined, eligibility, employment termination and benefit effective dates, impact on insurance, and other important considerations. Members are also encouraged to use online resources such as the retirement benefits calculator.

The video can be viewed any time. It provides a convenient alternative for members who are unable to attend a live webinar on the same topic with an ETF benefits specialist.

Web and Video Analytics

There was an increase of 39.2% in visitors to the ETF website for Quarter 1, 2024, (January-March) compared to the previous quarter. This web traffic pattern is consistent with the same time last year. While there was a decrease in searches to find ETF-administered benefits by employer, the site-wide search increased by almost 40%.

The attached quarterly web and video analytics report also shows popular topics of interest, including the January 2024 edition of the retiree newsletter when calendar year investment returns and projections for annuity adjustments were announced. Members were preparing for tax season as "How to Use ETF's Online Tax Withholding Calculator" was the third top watched video. The most watched video was "Applying for Retirement," followed by "WRS Effective Rates and Annuity Adjustments."

Website visitors gave the site an average score of 3 out of 5 on a 1 to 5 scale with 5 being the best.

Other Updates

- Website Content The ETF website has two new insurance pages on coverage guidelines for <u>preventive drugs</u> for non-Medicare members and <u>preventive care</u> <u>services</u>. These drugs and services are covered at 100% with no out-of-pocket costs for Group Health Insurance Program (GHIP) members, per the Affordable Care Act.
- New GHIP Brochure ETF recently published a new <u>brochure</u> (ET-7108) on the GHIP. The brochure provides an overview of the medical, pharmacy, and other insurance benefits administered by ETF. Updated annually, the brochure will be used in outreach to legislators and other stakeholders.
- Member Stories Beginning with the May 2024 editions of the member newsletters, ETF resumed collecting stories from active employees and retirees about their personal journeys in public service and living in retirement, respectively. Members' stories will be used in future communications. Members can email their stories to etfsmbcommunications@etf.wi.gov.
