**SUBJECT:** Pharmacy Benefit Manager Request for Proposal

Staff requests that the Board authorize staff to proceed with the release of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for administration of Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) services.

The Department is set to release an RFP for PBM services subsequent to Board approval. The contract with the current PBM, Navitus Health Solutions, LLC, will expire on December 31, 2010. Staff expects to bring a recommendation and proposal to award a new contract to the Board at its February 2010 meeting.

## **Background**

In 2002 the *Health Insurance Study Group* convened to recommend to the Board changes regarding the design of the group health insurance program. One of the recommendations was to utilize a pharmacy benefit manager to provide pharmacy services to all participants. Subsequently, the Board chose to contract with DeanPoint, Inc., which later became Navitus Health Solutions. The proposed RFP was developed to be consistent with the goals and methods used in the 2003 process.

## The PBM RFP

The objective of the RFP is to ensure that the PBM selected is able to provide services that will accommodate and enhance the current pharmacy benefit plan design. It is staff's intent to contract for the most transparent, cost-effective pricing and service agreement and select a PBM that is committed to working for the benefit of the State and the Wisconsin Public Employers group health insurance programs and its members.
