**SUBJECT:** Communicating Benefit Changes to Members

**This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.**

The Insurance Administration Bureau, in coordination with the Office of Communications and Legislation, is responsible for developing a plan for communicating to members changes to the Wisconsin Group Health Insurance Program due to 2011 Wisconsin Acts 10 and 32. The following plan was developed to ensure that our members have the most accurate information so that they can make informed decisions.

There are significant changes to the program and many members are starting to express concerns over the future of their coverage. We assembled a plan that attempts to reach a large number of members as quickly as possible, using a variety of tools to share information and answer questions from both members and employers.

The attachment provides details of the Department's plan to provide information to our members and employers. A number of these tasks are either complete or underway, and staff will continue to make progress to ensure that our members and employers have timely information.

There are two key periods in which timing is important for members:

- the first payroll deduction in which employees must start paying more for their premiums; and

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- the It's Your Choice enrollment period.

During the first payroll deduction period, per section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code, employees can elect to change coverage levels or enrollment due to a **significant change in premium payments**. The Department has determined that the change in the employee contribution is a significant increase.

During the It's Your Choice enrollment period, members have the option to change coverage. Also, due to the Group Insurance Board's decision to allow for open enrollment this fall, members now have the option to either elect coverage, if they were not previously enrolled, or drop coverage. The It's Your Choice materials are considered an authoritative reference for the Wisconsin Group Health Insurance Program, so the Department is working hard to ensure that benefit change information is accurately and clearly explained in these documents.

Staff will be at the August 23, 2011, meeting to answer any questions you may have.
