SUBJECT: 2015 It's Your Choice Enrollment Results

## This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

This memo highlights the enrollment shifts during the 2015 *It's Your Choice* (IYC) enrollment period. Attached are two tables that summarize health plan enrollment as of January 1, 2015, with a comparison to January 1, 2014:

- Attachment A: State of Wisconsin Group Health Insurance Program (State), January 2015
- Attachment B: Wisconsin Public Employers Group Health Insurance Program (WPE), January 2015

### High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) Contract Enrollment Experience

The most significant health insurance change for 2015 was the implementation of the HDHP option. HDHP enrollment for the first year yielded 427 State contracts (.44% of all covered employees). The highest HDHP enrollment was in Dean Health Insurance with 60 contracts (14.05% of total HDHP enrollment), and the second highest was in Unity Health Insurance–UW Health, with 49 contracts (11.48% of total HDHP). No WPE employers offered the HDHP option.

HDHP enrollment in the first year was expected to be low, primarily due to the short timeframe available to promote the plan before the enrollment period. Increased enrollment in subsequent years is possible, particularly as members become more familiar with the HDHP option.

HDHP offerings are tiered in the same way as the other health plans, but they have lower premiums for both the employer and employee premium contribution. The HDHP is not available to graduate assistants or Medicare-eligible annuitants.

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## **Summary of Health Plan Changes**

Overall, the group health insurance program experienced a small increase in the total number of contracts from 111,668 in 2014 to 112,082 in 2015.

The State program increased by 345 contracts (0.36%) and the WPE program by 69 (0.44%). The following paragraphs highlight changes that may have affected enrollments. Please note that ETF does not ask subscribers why they make enrollment changes.

- A number of health plans added or split service areas in 2015. WEA Trust created two individual plans in the Northwest service area Mayo Clinic Health System and Chippewa Valley. Members were required to choose one of the two for 2015.
- WPS is no longer offering WPS Metro Choice Northwest or WPS Metro Choice Southeast.
- Arise Health Plan expanded its service area and created two separate regions: Northern and Southeast.

#### **County Qualification Changes**

### **Tiering Changes**

In the WPE program, four health plans were designated Tier 3 plans:

- Group Health Cooperative (GHC) of Eau Claire
- Humana Eastern
- Humana Western
- Security Health Plan

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The tiering changes in the WPE program did not have a significant effect on enrollment shifts. The majority of subscribers in the WPE program choose the low-cost health plan offered in their respective county.

There were no tiering changes in the state program for 2015.

### It's Your Choice Applications Submitted for 2015

A total of 7,596 IYC requests to change coverage were submitted for 2015, reflecting an increase of 5.29% over 2014. Of the requests submitted, 4,378 were requests to change health plans. The following summarizes all 2015 IYC requests:

- 4,378 health plan change
- 659 add dependent
- 584 remove dependent
- 1,210 new enrollment
- 400 change from single to family coverage
- 365 change from family to single coverage

The number of health plan change requests is slightly higher than normal for any given IYC open enrollment period. There was a significant switch in the low-cost qualified health plans in the WPE program in several counties, which may account for a slight increase in health plan change requests. Other contributing factors include:

- the introduction of the state program HDHP option;
- health plan network changes (Arise Health Plan and WEA Trust Northwest service area); and
- three health plans changing their dental provider network to Delta Dental (Dean Health Insurance, Gundersen Health Plan, and WEA Trust).

#### **Health Plan Contract Gains and Losses**

More competitive pricing in 2015 led to an increase in member plan election changes in the WPE program. The low-cost qualified plan for many counties changed for 2015, causing an enrollment shift in some counties.

- Anthem Southeast increased from 138 to 770 contracts (a 457.9% increase) in the WPE program for 2015. This can be attributed to Anthem becoming the low-cost provider in Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, and Washington counties for 2015. WEA Trust East lost 708 WPE contracts (a 66% reduction).
- Medical Associates also experienced a significant increase in WPE contracts because it is now the low-cost health plan in LaFayette, Iowa, and Grant Counties. Enrollment shifted from 27 contracts in 2014 to 228 contracts in 2015 (a 744.4% increase).

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- WEA Trust Northwest split into two plans: WEA Trust-Northwest Chippewa Valley and WEA Trust-Northwest Mayo Clinic Health System. For 2015 WEA Trust experienced a net decrease of 374 contracts in the Northwest plan. The contracts lost by WEA Northwest were acquired by HealthPartners Health Plan, Security Health Plan and Humana Western.
- WPS Metro Choice Northwest and Southeast withdrew from the program, requiring 271 subscribers to switch health plans. Only one contract was under the WPE program and the rest were under the State program. WPS Metro Choice Northwest contracts were primarily picked up by HealthPartners Health Plan, which was either newly available or newly qualified in most of the affected counties.
- Unity continues to experience enrollment increases and is still the health plan with the most contracts in the program. Total contracts (including HDHP) increased 5.8% over last year (from 20,688 to 21,897). Unity now has 19.53% of the total contracts (self-insured and fully insured) in the health insurance program. Physicians Plus lost 230 contracts for 2015, primarily to Unity, despite adding UW Hospital and Clinics as an in-network provider for 2015.
- Dean Health Insurance is second in total contracts, with 19,166 in 2015 -- including the highest HDHP enrollment with 60 contracts.
- Two health plans were under the 100 contract threshold for remaining in the group health insurance program in 2014. Both Dean Health Insurance-Prevea360 Health Plan (4 contracts in 2014 and 44 in 2015) and WEA Trust-South Central (22 contracts in 2014 and 68 in 2015) continue to be below that threshold in 2015. Although both plans gained contracts for 2015, ETF staff will continue to monitor enrollment.
