Subject: 2016 It's Your Choice Report Card Summary

This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

This memo provides a brief summary of the performance of participating health plans, as indicated in the report card for the 2016 It's Your Choice (IYC) enrollment period. Attached are two tables that summarize the report card results for the 2015 and 2016 IYC enrollment periods.

Background

The report card provides comparative information to help members objectively evaluate health plan performance as they make their selections during the IYC enrollment period. The report card is based on the following:

- Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) measures that are
 defined by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) and assist with
 comparing the performance of health plans across a variety of health and
 disease categories. HEDIS measures in the 2016 IYC report card were submitted
 by health plans in 2015 and are based on 2014 data.
- Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS) survey
 that is maintained by the Agency for Healthcare Quality and Research (AHQR).
 The CAHPS survey asks members to report and evaluate their experiences with
 health care service delivery. CAHPS results in the 2016 IYC report card are
 based on a survey conducted in 2015.
- Grievances filed with health plans. Grievance ratings in the 2016 IYC report card are based on 2014 data.

Report Card Results

The report card consists of four composite ratings that assess how well the health plans are performing based on various HEDIS and CAHPS measures. A fifth rating is based solely on the number of grievances filed with the health plans. All of the ratings use a five-star scoring system in the report card in which five stars indicates the highest scoring plan(s) and one star indicates the lowest scoring health plans.

There is much variation noted among the health plans in report card performance and no health plan is a top or a bottom performer in every rating category.

The five ratings are summarized below.

1. Overall Performance: This composite rating is used for the "quality credit" that is provided to high performing health plans during the rate negotiation process. It provides a broad picture of how well the health plans are performing. It is comprised of nine HEDIS and CAHPS measures that include controlling high blood pressure, preventing readmissions to a hospital and avoiding overuse of antibiotics. The highest and lowest scoring health plans are shown below:

2. Quality: This composite compares how well health plans are performing in helping members with the maintenance and improvement of their health. It is comprised of eight HEDIS and CAHPS measures that include keeping cholesterol and blood pressure in check, getting screenings for breast cancer and colorectal cancer, and how well members think their health plan, primary care and specialist doctors are performing. The highest and lowest scoring health plans are shown below:

3. <u>Care Coordination:</u> This composite compares how well health plans manage health care services over time. It is comprised of seven HEDIS and CAHPS measures that include managing medications over time related to antidepressants, asthma, and attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), and how well members think their health plan is helping with coordinating care. The highest and lowest scoring health plans are shown below:

4. Overuse of Services: This composite compares how well health plans use services wisely and avoid using services when they are not needed. It is comprised of four HEDIS measures that include overuse of imaging (CT scans, MRIs and x-rays), and using antibiotics appropriately for children with upper respiratory infections or pharyngitis. The highest and lowest scoring health plans are shown below:

5. <u>Grievances:</u> The health plan's grievance process is the first step in resolving member complaints. This rating is based on the number of grievances filed per 1,000 members in the state and local health insurance programs. Lower grievance rates have higher star ratings in the report card. The highest and lowest scoring health plans are shown below:
