I am writing this letter on behalf of my patients that have a diagnosis of obesity. Wisconsin ranks 25<sup>th</sup> in the country of the states that are impacted by obesity. Patients are in need of anti-obesity medications that are currently not covered by their insurance plan. 33.9% of people in Wisconsin are obese. Obesity is a complex chronic disease. Healthcare costs are 39.4% higher for people with obesity.
