Please find attached the *WRS Retirement Benefit Information* for the year 2010. This document contains information reflecting the retirement benefit activities administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. The data presented covers participant retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and WRS annuity payment information. It also contains data applicable to customer service functions.

Of particular interest is the trend with retirement estimate requests, which were up 36.6% in the 4th quarter of 2010, as compared to the 4th quarter of 2009. For the year, both retirement estimate requests and retirement applications show an increase.




WRS Special Project Update Variable at Core

- There are approximately 32,000 annuitants who participate in the Variable Fund.
- Unless an annuitant completed and submitted a Variable cancellation form, the Department did not keep track of whether an annuitant's participation in the Variable Fund resulted in an annuity that was higher or lower than if the annuitant had not participated in the Variable Fund.
- In 2010, the Department began a project to provide annuitants participating in the Variable Fund this information.
- This project began January 11, 2010, with 32,553 files in need of review. Some files had multiple fund sources, requiring 34,188 separate calculations.
- Annuitants can now monitor their "variable at core" balance, as it is updated automatically each year by the Benefit Payment System.


WRS RETIREMENT ANNUTIES

Benefit Options Taken Finalized Annuities and Lump Sum Retirement Benefits 4th Quarter 2010





Benefit Options Taken Finalized Annuities and Lump Sum Retirement Benefits Year 2010


