SUBJECT: Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS) Benefit Information

This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

Please find attached the WRS Benefit Information report for the period July -September 2011. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and WRS annuity payment information. It also contains data having to do with customer service functions.

Both the retirement estimates requested and the new annuities started in 2011 continue to be of interest. Both decreased during the third quarter, when compared to the first and second quarter, but this is typical in any calendar year. Of more interest is a comparison of this year's and last year's data:

- When comparing the number of retirement estimates requests received during the first three guarters of 2011 with the same period in 2010, retirement estimate requests increased by 50.4%.
- When comparing the number of retirement benefit applications received during the first three quarters of 2011 with the same period in 2010, retirement applications increased by 74.0%. This comparison takes into account retirement applications for annuities as well as applications for lump sums.



Telephone Calls to Main Line 3rd Quarter 2011

- During the period July September 2011, there were 35,674 calls received on the main member line.
- Calls decreased compared to the previous quarter, which was very busy due to mailing of Annual Statements and annuity adjustment information. In addition, fewer retirement estimates were requested this quarter.





Benefit Options Taken Finalized Annuities and Lump Sum Retirement Benefits 3rd Quarter 2011




Trends – Retirement Estimates and Applications
