#### This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

Please find attached the Wisconsin Retirement System (*WRS*) *Benefit Information* report, including data from the second quarter of 2013. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and WRS annuity payment information. It also contains data having to do with customer service functions.

Comparing the second quarter of this year to the same time period last year, the number of retirement estimate requests has increased by 11.9%, and the number of retirement applications has increased by 20.7%.
