Please find attached the *Retirement Services Update* report, including data from calendar year 2013. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and annuity payment information for the Wisconsin Retirement System. It also contains data associated with customer service functions.

The number of retirement estimate requests received during 2013 was 2.2% less than that received during 2012. The number of retirement benefit applications received during 2013, was 12.9% more than the number of applications during 2012.








