This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

Please find attached the *Retirement Services Update* report, including data from the second quarter of 2014. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and annuity payment information for the Wisconsin Retirement System.

The number of retirement estimate requests received during the second quarter of 2014 was 7.6% greater than the number received during the second quarter of 2013. The number of retirement benefit applications received during the second quarter of 2014 was 9.7% less than the number of applications received during the second quarter of 2013.




Retirement Benefit Options - 2014 Year-to-date






CALCULATION METHOD - 2 Q 2014




EMPLOYER - 2 Q 2014
