Please find attached the *Retirement Services Update* report, including data from the third quarter of 2014. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and annuity payment information for the Wisconsin Retirement System. It also contains data associated with customer service functions.

The number of retirement estimate requests received during third quarter in 2014 was 7.1% greater than that received during third quarter 2013. The number of retirement benefit applications received during third quarter 2014 was 4.9% greater than the number of applications received during third quarter 2013.




Retirement Benefit Options - 2014 Year-to-date






CALCULATION METHOD - 3 Q 2014




EMPLOYER - **3 Q 2014**
