SUBJECT: Retirement Services Update

This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

Please find attached the *Retirement Services Update* report, including data from the first quarter of 2015. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and annuity payment information for the Wisconsin Retirement System. It also contains data associated with customer service functions.

The number of retirement estimate requests received during the first quarter of 2015 was 14.4% lower than those received during the first quarter of 2014. The number of retirement benefit applications received during first quarter 2015 was 4.9% lower than the number of applications received during first quarter 2014.




Retirement Benefits Finalized - Calendar Year 2015

3 Beneficiary Annuity Termination occurred during the 1st Quarter of 2015






Fund Source - 1Q 2015


