This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

Please find attached the *Retirement Services Update* report, including data from the third quarter of 2016. This document contains information about retirement benefits administered by the Department of Employee Trust Funds. Specifically, the data covers member retirement estimates requested, new annuities started, and annuity payment information for the Wisconsin Retirement System. It also contains data associated with customer service functions.

The number of retirement estimate requests received during the third quarter of 2016 was 11.4% lower than those received during the third quarter of 2015. The number of retirement benefit applications received during third quarter 2016 was 20.1% lower than the number of applications received during third quarter 2015.

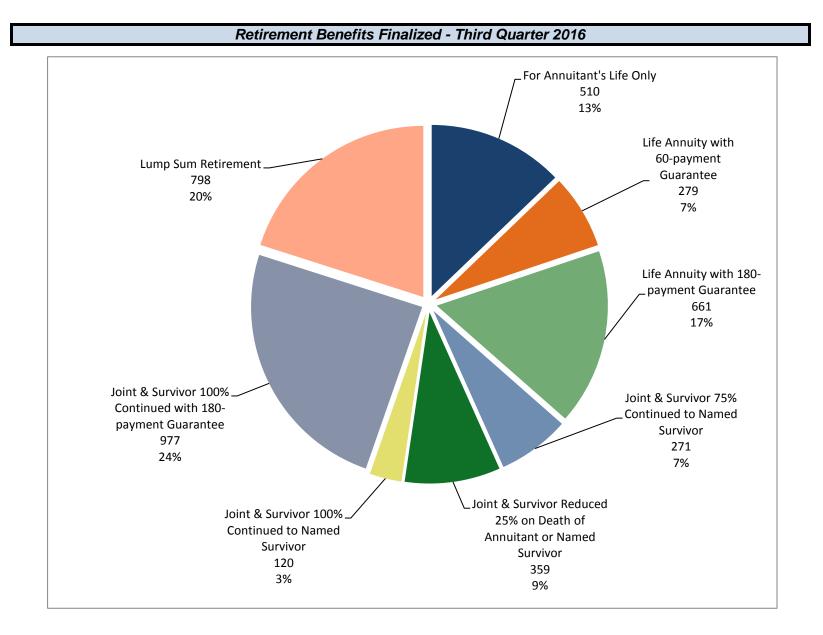

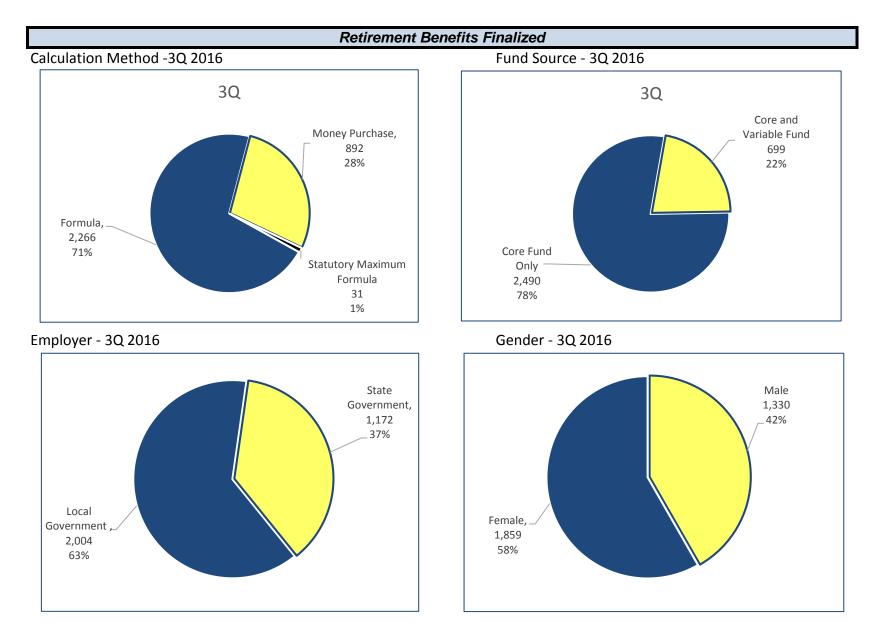

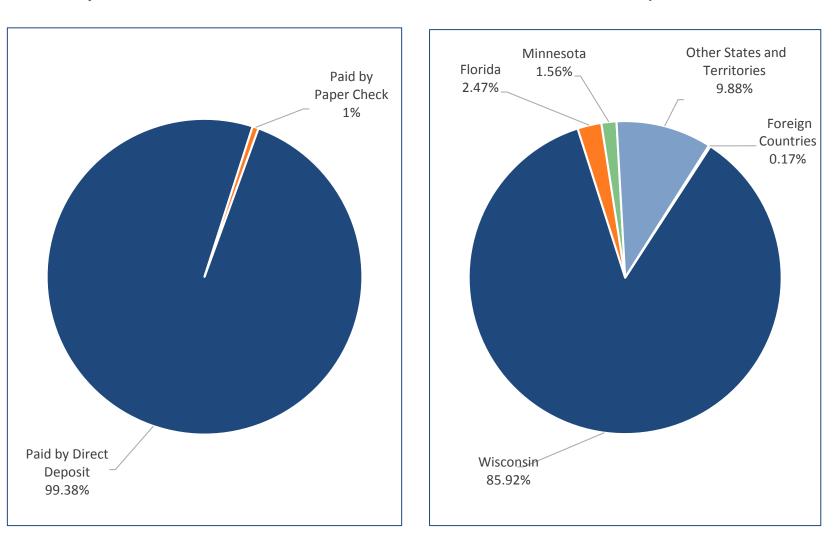
