Subject: Communications Update

This memo is for informational purposes only. No Board action is required.

ETF Website: Metrics

The <u>website</u> had a spike in traffic during Quarter 3, 2020 (July 1-September 30), especially leading up to the annual open enrollment period that began at the end of September.

Compared to the previous quarter, there was a:

- 9.5% increase in site users
- 15.2% increase in page views
- 12.5% increase in sessions

The bounce rate also increased slightly by 1.6% to 47%, but it is still below the 50% threshold. A higher bounce rate means users are not going deeper into the site, which may not be a problem as long as they are finding what they need. Other engagement scores, such as pages viewed per session and session duration, also increased.

Another important factor is user satisfaction tracked from web page surveys. During this quarter, 60% of survey respondents say information was helpful. Responses represent 2.7% of site visitors, which is typical. A common problem was broken links due to use of Internet Explorer, which is no longer supported by Microsoft. Users are directed to use Google Chrome for an optimal experience.

The attached website analytics quarterly report provides more details about site impact, engagement, search terms, downloaded materials, and other metrics.

ETF Website: Improvements

We added <u>Health</u> to the site's top navigation to make it easier for members to access information and resources about their options for health insurance, pharmacy, dental, vision, and supplemental benefits. Other content and organization changes were also made in time for open enrollment (September 28-October 23), based on feedback from members and employers.

The website now offers members the opportunity to easily and securely complete certain online transactions such as:

- Electronic transfer of additional contributions to their Wisconsin Retirement System account
- Scheduling a benefits counseling appointment
- Completing and submitting the *Group Health Insurance Application/Change for Retirees & COBRA Continuants* (ET-2331) form electronically

To assist members in using electronic forms, we created a simple how-to video. In addition, other frequently used benefits forms are being reviewed for conversion to Adobe Acrobat Reader fillable forms that can be completed and submitted electronically.

Member Communications and Education

- <u>November WRS News Online</u> This e-newsletter for employees covers important year-end benefits deadlines, flu shots, and the upcoming Teachers Retirement Board elections, among other things.
- Health benefit webinars ETF offered more than 20 webinars with Q&A during open enrollment, in lieu of onsite benefits fairs due the pandemic. Total participants: 1,796. Results of survey respondents:
 - o 76% are somewhat satisfied or very satisfied with their experience
 - o 92% say it was very easy or extremely easy to register online
 - 75% will recommend the webinar(s) to their coworkers
- 2020 Member Engagement Survey This confidential and anonymous survey is set to be emailed to more than 150,000 members in November. The survey measures members' overall satisfaction and how easy it is to complete interactions with ETF, among other things.
- Financial wellness grant ETF and the Department of Financial Institutions were recently awarded a \$100,000 grant to provide financial wellness education and resources for Wisconsin public service employees, retirees, and their families. The grant is a collaboration between the Center for State and Local Government Excellence, the International Public Management Association for Human Resources, the National Association of State Treasurers Foundation, and Wells Fargo. Watch for future updates on this initiative throughout 2021.











How quickly are pages loading?

Site Impact

Users: a person who has visited and interacted with the site
Pageviews: the recorded number of times a page is viewed by a user during the reporting period
Unique Pageviews: the number of pageviews by a user during a session
Sessions: a series of pageviews that a single user makes during a period of web activity. The session ends after the user either closes the browser, clears cookies, or is inactive for 30 minutes

Engagement

The number of pages users have viewed per session and how long they were on the site.

Bounce Rate: the number of users who viewed one page and left the site

Avg. Session Duration: the amount of time users are spending on the site

Pages/Session: the average number of pageviews in each session

New Visitor: a person who visited the site for the first time from a specific device

Returning Visitor: a person who visited the site before and returned using the same device

Source

Tracking how users come to the site and what type of device they use.

Full Referrer: an external site or application that directed the user to our site

Organic Search: users came to the site by entering terms into a search engine

Referral: users came to the site from a link on another website

Direct: users came to the site from an external direct link

Summary

The website had a spike in traffic for CY 2020 Quarter 3, especially leading up to the annual open enrollment period (September 28-October 23) at the end of September.

Hot Topics - Out of the 52,625 total site searches, "Decision Guide" is the #1 search term followed by searches for webinars on health insurance, pharmacy, dental, vision, and supplemental benefits.

Downloads - Direct Deposit Authorization (ET-7282) is the #1 downloaded form followed by the Address/Name Change (ET-2815) and Group Health Insurance Application/Change for Retirees and COBRA Continuants (ET-2331) forms.

Satisfaction - Another important factor is user satisfaction tracked from web page surveys and available in a separate report. Sixty percent of survey respondents say information was helpful for CY 2020 Quarter 3. Responses represent 2.7% of site visitors, which is typical. A common problem was broken links due to use of Internet Explorer, which is no longer supported by Microsoft. Users are directed to use Chrome for an optimal experience.

Watch For - We anticipate increased site traffic in October 2020 due to the annual open enrollment period. Beginning in CY 2020 Quarter 4, we will have a full year of data since the website redesign. This will allow us to compare metrics by quarter to the previous year at the same time. We are still including ETF IP addresses, which will be removed in the future.
