## Definitions



### **Domestic Relations Order (DRO)**



#### Qualified Domestic Relations Order (QDRO)



A domestic relations order that has been qualified (officially recognized) and accepted by the Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF)

### **ETF Will Send in the Mail**

- Notification of your account division and new service and account balances
- Beneficiary Designation form to update your beneficiaries
  - This does not get automatically updated, you must submit a new copy to remove your ex-spouse
- This packet may also include retirement information if you are at or near minimum retirement age
