

Cost-Saving Tips

1. Contact Navitus to learn about alternative, lower-cost drug options

Discuss any alternatives with your doctor – call or use a messaging feature such as MyChart.

2. Use the mail order pharmacy to have medicine delivered to your door

Sign up at https://pharmacy.costco.com to get a 90-day supply of most maintenance medications for 2 copays, instead of 3.

3. Check the cost of your drug at other pharmacies

Visit https://etf.benefits.navitus.com/ and select your plan design to preview how much your prescription will cost at a specific pharmacy. To compare costs between pharmacies, log in to Navi-Gate for members.

4. Enroll in a health care flexible spending account

Set aside pre-tax dollars to pay your out-of-pocket medical expenses.

5. Use the Navitus discount list for non-covered drugs

For drugs such as allergy, acne or infertility medications not covered by your plan.

| Cost-Share Level | Copay/Coinsurance |
|--|-------------------|
| Level 1 80% of all prescriptions filled, mostly generics | \$5 |
| Level 2 Preferred drugs, work well for most people | 20% (\$50 Max) |
| Level 3 – Approved FDA MedWatch Form Typically brand name drugs with lower cost generic options at levels 1 or 2 See the Level 3 Cost Sharing Example Handout to learn more. | 40% (\$150 Max) |
| Level 4 Specialty drugs used to treat complex, chronic illnesses. Must be filled at a specialty pharmacy. | \$50 |
